A Mehendi Competition was conducted in Room 109 at 2:00 PM. Students showcased beautiful mehendi designs reflecting creativity and cultural art.









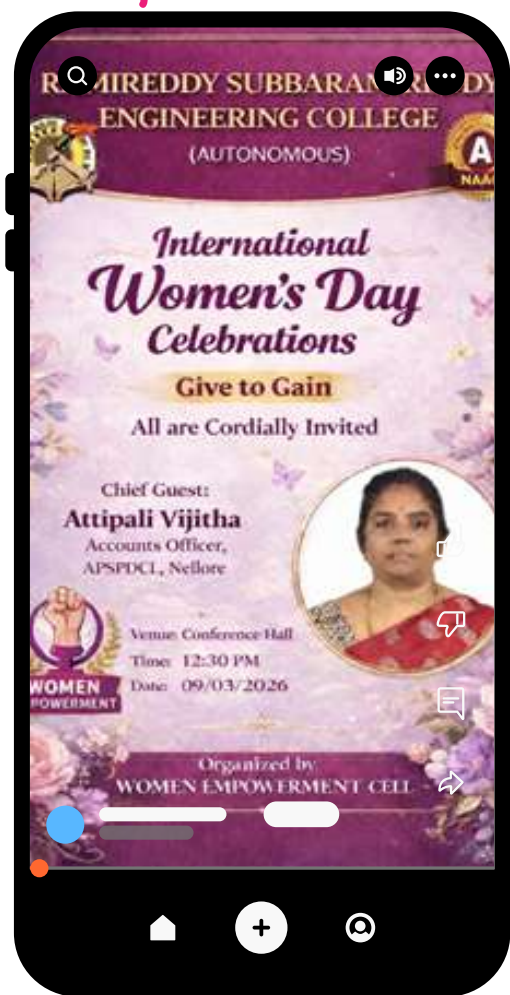
Day 3 – Main Women’s Day Celebration (09 March 2026)
